Position

Full-time teacher of English at a private Japanese junior-senior high school

Location

Neyagawa City, Osaka

Responsibilities

Primary responsibility

Work collaboratively with a Japanese co-teacher to prepare and teach weekly lessons to students. Lessons will cover Ministry of Education-approved content for one or more of the following subjects:

• English (junior - grade 1-3)(senior - grade 1-3)

Other responsibilities

- Share homeroom duties with another full-time (Japanese) teacher
- Select and prepare learning materials
- Prepare and grade assignments and tests
- Provide appropriate feedback to students and their parents/guardians in regards to students' academic performance
- Adhere to all applicable school policies regarding behavior, dress, etc.
- Serve as a positive role-model for all members of the school community
- Participate in periodic meetings with other teachers and administrators
- Assist with school-related events, including school information sessions, sports day events, etc.

Job requirements

- Must be eligible to legally work in Japan;
- Must have a bachelors degree or higher from a university in an Englishspeaking country. (extensive studies in TESOL or TEFL preferred)
- Must be a fluent speaker of English with knowledge of how English usage varies around the world;
- Must have some familiarity with language teaching pedagogy;
- Must have experience teaching junior and/or senior high school students (preferably including classes of 10 or more students);



- Must be able to deliver engaging lessons to large groups of students;
- Must be able and willing to work collaboratively with other teachers and administrators;
- Must be dedicated and hard-working;
- Must be flexible and resilient.

NOTE: It is not required that the candidate possess Japanese language skills. However, since this is a homeroom position, you should expect frequent interaction with Japanese teaching staff, parents and adminiration. So basic Japanese language skills would be beneficial.

In addition to the above requirements, the school prefers candidates that are:

- Friendly and easygoing;
- Familiar with Japanese customs and culture;
- Familiar with Japanese school life and the role of teachers;
- Proficient in the use of computer hardware and software (including MS-Word, PowerPoint, etc.); can make effective use of technology in the classroom and can mentor students in the effective use of technology to aid learning.

Opening and closing time : opening time 8:20, Closing time12:20 Xa half holiday shall be supplied from Monday to Friday


Work performed outside of the above hours is compensated in accordance with applicable school policy.
